The SIG's inaugural meeting is scheduled for 2019 and develop an action plan to facilitate a strategic framework for transport data management.
3 April 2019 Cape Town	Workshop Taking Action to Mitigate Congestion	Congestion is a very serious issue with significant consequences, and it requires a coordinated response from multiple stakeholders. ITSSA will host a workshop titled "Taking Action to Mitigate Congestion". While many of the presentations will focus on information from the City of Cape Town, given the city's status as the "most congested city in South Africa", the objective of the workshop is to use such information as a case study and establish learning points of value for application for all our cities. This workshop aims to be an initial step in establishing broader collaboration amongst the wide spectrum of influential stakeholders, in which ITSSA can play a role.
28 May 2019 Midrand	Members Meeting Briefing on Gauteng Transport Authority	The Gauteng Transport Authority Bill was recently adopted by the Provincial Legislature as a vital step for integrated transport planning and co-ordination of public transport operations across the province. The Transport Authority will cover the Gauteng City Region, involving the provincial department of roads and transport and municipal transport administrations. The Gauteng Transport Authority – currently in the process of being legally established - will co-ordinate the planning, integration and enforcement of public transport operations in the province. The Gautrain Management Agency (GMA) CEO Jack van der Merwe has been appointed for an initial period of six month to steer the establishment of the Gauteng Transport Authority (GTA). Jack will do a briefing on the envisaged operations of the GTA at a Members Meeting.
